Monday April 1st: John 11: 1 - 16

Pray for those who are having to wait to see their prayers answered.

Tuesday April 2nd: John 11: 17 - 27

See the faith and despair in the story. See Martha's faith even before the miracle, and pray for a trust like hers.

Wednesday April 3rd: John 11: 28 - 37

God is moved by the situations we face. Look at the news and try to see issues as God might. Pray for others with compassion.

Thursday April 4th: John 11: 38 - 44

Imagine the joy of having Lazarus restored. Praise God for his love remembering that he has power over life and death!

Friday April 5th: John 11: 45 - end.

Pray for corrupt leaders; that they will see the error of their ways. Pray for the persecuted.

Saturday April 6th: John 12: 1 - 11

Amid our busy lives, it is important to remember that we have Jesus with us. He needs to be our priority.

SUNDAY April 7th: Matthew 27: 33 - 54

Remember with thanksgiving our Lord's crucifixion and death.

Monday 8th: John 12: 12 - 19

Think of recent popular movements, and how crowds can get carried away. Pray for those feeling disillusionment, and praise God for the real truth in the Triumphal Entry.

Tuesday April 9th: John 12: 36b - end

We think of the conflicting views we face. Pray for young people facing peer pressure, and ask that we all may acknowledge our faith in these times.

Wednesday April 10th: John 13: 1 - 11

Reflect on Jesus love and humility and consider whether you have a humility like his.

Thursday April 11th: John 13: 12 - 20

Reflect on how you may serve others and offer hospitality to those in need.

Friday April 12th: John 13: 21 - 30

Pray for any people who feel betrayed at this time, by a family member, the church or their country etc.

Saturday April 13th: John 13: 31 - end

Reflect on the command to "Love one another", and pray that others will see that we are his disciples.

SUNDAY April 14th: Luke 19: 29 - end

Think of anything in the church that might detract from its message- and pray for courage to speak our against injustices.

Monday 15th: John 14: 1 - 14

Pray for those who are anxious, that they will know Christ's peace and presence.

Tuesday April 16th: John 15: 1 - 17

Think of those people you know who no longer attend church, and pray for them.

Wednesday April 17th: John 16: 1 - 15

Remember those who are feel divided. Give thanks that the Spirit will guide and is at work today.

Thursday April 18th: John 17: 1 - end

It is good to pray for others and to remember that Jesus prays for us, that we may fulfil his will.

Friday April 19th: John 18: 1 - end

We call to mind our Lord`s arrest and give thanks for all he endured for us. Pray for those going through testing times and those living in corrupt societies.

Saturday April 20th: 1 Peter 4: 1 - 6

We remember to live for God. Pray for new Christians, that they will keep making good choices before God.

SUNDAY April 21st: John 20: 11 - 23

Praise God for all that Easter means! Pray for those who find the message difficult to believe, that they will trust and have faith.

Monday 22nd: Luke 24: 1 - 12

Pray that others will come to see the truth for themselves as did Peter. Pray for those asking questions.

Tuesday April 23rd: Matthew 28: 1 - 15

Try not be afraid, but pray for help to pass on the news of the gospel.

Wednesday April 24th: Matthew 28: 16 - end

Thank God for those who have handed the faith down to you and be inspired to do likewise.

Thursday April 25th: Mark 16: 1- 20

Pray for those apprehensive of the future; of difficulties to be faced. Pray that they will see God at work.

Friday April 26th: Acts 17: 16 - 31

Saturday April 27th: Acts 26: 1 - 23

Think of how you might tell your faith story.

SUNDAY April 28th: Rev 2: 1 - 11

Pray for those whose faith is being tested to the limits. Pray for strength for them to keep going.

Monday 29th: 1 Timothy 1: 1 - 17

Remember that God can bring about changes. Pray for individuals who are yet to come to faith.
