Tuesday September 1st : Luke 10

Wednesday September 2nd: John 4

Thursday September 3rd: Genesis 1

Give thanks to God for the wonderful world he made, in all its variety and beauty.

Friday September 4th: Genesis 2

In your prayers today, think of the people who have made life special for you.

Saturday September 5th: Genesis 3

Consider the ways the world has gone against what God intended, and pray for forgiveness from God for the mistakes that have been made.

SUNDAY September 6th: Matthew 13

We reap what we sow in many ways, either in life, or in practical ways such as the way we plant crops. Give thanks for the positive people who have sown good seed in your life.

Monday September 7th: Proverbs 3 especially v 9

Consider in your prayers today whether you give God the best, and the first fruits of your labours.

Tuesday September 8th: Galatians 6

This has been a tough year for everyone, businesses are under pressure and it must be hard not to feel like giving up. Pray for business people that you know.

Wednesday September 9th: James 5

Pray today for those who are impatient and feeling worn down by life.

Thursday September 10th: Revelation 14

The imagery of harvesting with a sickle brings to mind times from the past when farmers brought in their crops this way, now we have machinery to do it. Give thanks for the minds who invented this machinery and enable more efficient working in the fields.

Friday September 11th Psalm 100

Pray for all the local farmers and their staff, saying thank you for all they do to provide us with fresh food..

Saturday September 12th: Exodus 23

Pray for food distributors across the world who work so hard to supply all our needs.

SUNDAY September 13th: Psalm 85

Thank God for all the good things you have been blessed with.

Monday September 14th: Ecclesiastes 3 v 1-12

Pray for those who plant, and also for those who have destroyed the earth by polluting it and not taking care of it.

Tuesday September 15th: Ephesians 4

Pray for people who are working hard to provide for their families by doing an honest days work for an honest days pay.

Wednesday September 16th: Jeremiah 8

Pray for those who have been harvesting the crops over the past month ready for the autumn.

Thursday September 17th: 2 Corinthians 9

Give thanks for those who give their offerings faithfully week by week ensuring our work can continue in these difficult days.

Friday September 18th: Psalm 67

Pray for those who are developing new crops, new medicines, and particularly a coronavirus vaccine at this time.

Saturday September 19th: Psalm 103

Praise God in your prayers today for the ways in which he has supported, blessed and assured you.

SUNDAY September 20th: Genesis 8

Give thanks in your prayers for the way the seasons keep on changing, from spring to summer, autumn to winter. We can see the wonder of creation in the way the world keeps on changing no matter what is happening.

Monday September 21st: Ruth 2

Ruth is a fine example of someone who is loyal, faithful and trustworthy. Pray for the people you know who are just like her .

Tuesday September 22^{nd:} Psalm 104

Praise God in prayer for creating a world that has stayed firm and sure despite all it has faced over thousands of years.

Wednesday September 23rd: John 6

Pray for people today who prepare and distribute food for the benefit of others.

Thursday September 24th: Isaiah 62

Pray for the places where grapes and other fruits are grown, wine is made, and fruit packed up for our benefit.

Friday September 25th: Psalm 126

Give thanks for the groups and activities that have made a difference to others in our community. These are seeds that are sown and then harvested.

Saturday September 26th: Joshua 1

Pray for people who are feeling weak and unsure, may they be strengthened and assured.

SUNDAY September 27th: Genesis 41

Pray that the world's resources will be shared fairly amongst all.

Monday September 28th: Leviticus 19

Pray for the places where the harvest is not going well, especially where the fields have been flooded and farmers face difficult times.

Tuesday September 29th: **Proverbs 6, especially verse 8** *Remember with thanks all those who prepare food, particularly in your home.*

Wednesday September 30th: 1 Samuel 12

Recently we have experienced all the seasons in a matter of days. One day thunder and lightning, the next beautiful sunshine! Give thanks today for the wonder of creation and particularly for its creator, our loving and faithful God.
