**SUNDAY                    November 1<sup>st</sup>:        Hebrews 13 v 1-19**

*Many people have sacrificed their freedom for others, and suffer as a result. Remember them in your prayers today.*

**Monday                    November 2<sup>nd</sup>:        Romans 12 v 1-12**

*What does it mean to be a living sacrifice? There are many answers to this, but one is that we use our time and talents in serving God, how can you do this?*

**Tuesday                   November 3<sup>rd</sup>:        John 3 v 1-16**

*God sacrificed His Son on the cross for all of us, the ultimate sacrifice paid for our sins. Reflect on that sacrifice today and thank God for this most precious gift.*

**Wednesday                November 4<sup>th</sup>:        Hosea 6**

*The prophet Hosea is longing for love and not sacrifice. Jesus sacrificed himself because of love. Praise Him in prayer for his courage and commitment.*

**Thursday                   November 5<sup>th</sup>:        Genesis 22**

*Sacrifices in the time of Abraham and Isaac were very different to what we expect nowadays. Pray about the sacrifices you are making at the moment.*

**Friday                      November 6<sup>th</sup>:        Philippians 2**

*Looking out for others has been very important during the Covid19 pandemic, some people have sacrificed a great deal for others. Give thanks for them today.*

**Saturday                   November 7<sup>th</sup>:        Ephesians 5**

*Jesus gave his all for us. He didn't just go the extra mile, he gave everything He had. Reflect on his sacrifice in your prayers today.*

**SUNDAY                    November 8<sup>th</sup>:        John 15**

*On this Remembrance Sunday remember the sacrifice of millions of people from all around the world who gave their lives in the service of their country.*

**Monday                    November 9<sup>th</sup>:        1 Peter 2**

*Pray today for the people who are an example of a living sacrifice, and give a lot of themselves to help others.*

**Tuesday                   November 10<sup>th</sup>:       Psalm 51**

*Remember in prayer people who have sacrificed a lot for their family or friends.*

**Wednesday      November 11<sup>th</sup>      1 Corinthians 13**

*There is no greater love than to lay down your life for your friends says Jesus in John 15. On this Remembrance Day let us not forget the love that has been given, treasured, cherished and received over the years.*

**Thursday      November 12<sup>th</sup>:      Mark 10**

*Pray for people who need to hear about the sacrifice that Jesus gave for them, pray that they might hear the Gospel message and act on it.*

**Friday      November 13<sup>th</sup>:      Hebrews 10**

*In this reading Paul reminds us not to keep on sinning after we have heard the Gospel message. Pray today for the strength to keep to God's way, now and always.*

**Saturday      November 14<sup>th</sup>:      Galatians 2**

*Jesus' sacrifice on the cross was for all of us – past, present and future. Reflect on this in your prayers today and remember He loves you so deeply that He gave His life for you.*

**SUNDAY      November 15<sup>th</sup>:      John 14**

*In your prayers today seek guidance for the path you should follow through life. Jesus promises that He is the way, the truth and the life, what should you do?*

**Monday      November 16<sup>th</sup>:      Titus 2**

*Pray for all those who seek to keep the peace in our world – Armed Forces, Police and Law Enforcement Agencies.*

**Tuesday      November 17<sup>th</sup>:      Luke 9**

*Give thanks for those who save lives on a daily basis, remembering our NHS in particular, but all medical teams.*

**Wednesday      November 18<sup>th</sup>:      Jonah 2**

*Pray for those who work with charities and organisations who seek to bring calm and peace to our world.*

**Thursday      November 19<sup>th</sup>:      John 1**

*John the Baptist knew Jesus was the One the world was waiting for. He sacrificed his relationship with others and stuck his head above the parapet to make clear who Jesus was. Pray for the modern day John the Baptist's!*

**Friday      November 20<sup>th</sup>:      Exodus 20**

*We may not need to sacrifice animals or other offerings, but we are asked to give a fitting proportion of our time,*

*skills and money. Pray about what you are offering at this time, is it a fitting gift to God?*

**Saturday                    November 21<sup>st</sup>:    Genesis 8**

*God said He would not sacrifice living creatures again after the flood. Yet we still see natural disasters. Why do we still see them? Share your thoughts in your prayers today .*

**SUNDAY                    November 22<sup>nd</sup>:    Matthew 12**

*Who do you need to forgive today? Share your thoughts in prayer today.*

**Monday                    November 23<sup>rd</sup>:    Matthew 10**

*Do you feel worthy today? Worthy of God's love? Worthy of your family's love? Take comfort in your prayers today that Jesus knows you are worthy, valued, and loved.*

**Tuesday                    November 24<sup>th</sup>:    1 John 1**

*Give thanks today for the positive, encouraging and nurturing people you are blessed to know.*

**Wednesday                November 25<sup>th</sup>:    Acts 3**

*Praise God for the people of faith, those who trust fully in God for everything that they have, and do in life.*

**Thursday                    November 26<sup>th</sup> :    Romans 5**

*Pray for the people who work for reconciliation between people and nations.*

**Friday                      November 27<sup>th</sup>:    1 John 5**

*Jesus' message is simple, love God and love your neighbour, but many people find that hard to do. Pray that more people would reach out for that love.*

**Saturday                    November 28<sup>th</sup>:    Romans 6**

*Pray that we will learn the lesson of being forgiven by Jesus, and be thankful for it.*

**SUNDAY                    November 29<sup>th</sup>:    2 Corinthians 5**

*We are blessed to be unique, cared for and loved. God has made each one of us with care and creativity, we are His "new creation". Give thanks in your prayers for this wonderful feeling.*

**Monday                      November 30<sup>th</sup>:    Romans 8**

*God gave all that He had, even His own Son. Praise God for this gift, the ultimate sacrifice, in your prayers today.*
